

Club Use

Club schedule

General club hours, childcare hours, and holiday hours are posted on our website. In addition, the website hosts a schedule of classes, programs and activities.

Guests of members

Adult members above the age of 18 have the option to bring in non-members as guests. All guests must register with club staff prior to gaining access to the facility. All guests must pay the applicable guest fee as listed below. There is no limit on the number of times a guest may use the facility when a guest fee is paid.

Premium members have access to guest privileges at no charge. Premium members may bring up to two free guests each visit. Any unique guest may only gain access via a free pass 5 times in a calendar year. After a person's 5th free pass all guest fees will apply or the guest should consider joining on a regular Courthouse membership. The Premium guest allowance is not meant to be a substitute for membership.

Kid and Junior members do not have guest privileges unless their guest is a parent or guardian. In this instance all guest policies apply, including the applicable guest fee. Kids and Juniors may not bring in guests under the age of 18 without a parent or guardian present, onsite. Guests must be accompanied by a current Courthouse member and the fees are as follows;

- Under the age of 1 (for swimming only) - No cost
- Age 1 to 13 - \$5
- Age 14 to 17 - \$10
- Age 18+ with a valid ID - \$10
- Members may bring up to 2 guests per visit, with a maximum of 4 guests per family.

Restricted Access

Some membership options may have restricted access as it pertains to time or space within the facility. Should a member with a time or area restriction wish to use outside of their limitation, they may do so for a fee. For instance, our "Basic" membership provides club access from 12p-4p. Members with this membership type may use outside of this timeframe for an additional fee of \$10 per instance.

Non-smoking environmen

Smoking or the use of vapors is not allowed within the club, or within 100 feet of a club entry.

Facility Use

Racquetball and squash court reservation

Members may reserve one court at a time up to seven days in advance for a maximum of 2 hours.

Dress for cardio, weight room, courts and fitness areas

Clothing and shoes designed specifically for exercise is required. Street clothes are not allowed. Shirts must be worn at all times. Please use shoes designed for the activity of choice (no sandals, boots, dress shoes etc.).

Dress for pool and spa

A modest suit designed specifically for swimming is required. Cut-offs or exercise apparel is prohibited in the pool. Loose or dangling jewelry should be removed prior to entering the pool. Cover-ups for swimwear and shoes are required outside the pool, sun deck and locker room areas. The club is not responsible for swimwear that fades or is damaged due to use in pools, spas or Suitmates.

Sauna and steam rooms

The sauna temperature is kept between 170F and 180F degrees and the steam room temperature is kept between 100F and 110F degrees. We suggest you limit yourself to a maximum of 10 minutes per session. Because of high temperatures, the steam room and sauna can be dangerous to your health. We recommend you consult your physician before you use them. Those who are pregnant and those with medical conditions such as high blood

pressure, heart disease, and respiratory problems should avoid exposure to high heat.

Some locations have co-ed steam and sauna rooms. In these clubs locations a swimsuit or athletic wear is required. Phones are not allowed in these areas.

Locker rooms

- Children age 4 and older are not allowed in the locker room of the opposite gender. If needed, private family changing rooms are provided in or near the pool area.
- Cell phones are not to be used in the locker rooms due to privacy concerns.
- It is the responsibility of each member and guest to properly secure their valuables. Courthouse is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- There are several day-use lockers in each locker room. These lockers are available for members and guests to use while they are in the club. Locks left on these lockers will be cut off at the end of each day and contents will be bagged, dated, and left at the service desk for the owner to claim. As with lost and found items, these items will be kept at the desk for 15 days, after which time they will be discarded. We do not keep personal hygiene items.
- Members should plan to use the locker room designated by the gender on their federal ID. In the case that no gender is specified, there are gender neutral changing rooms available at each facility.

Shower towels and private lockers

Rentable Shower towels are \$1 per use and will be charged to a member account each month as they are requested. Members can also access towel service with a Premium membership/service. Private lockers may be rented for \$6 per month per location.

Club Damage

The club anticipates normal wear and tear to the facility and equipment due to regular member use. The club monitors most areas of the facility. In the event that a member or guest is found vandalizing, damaging or destroying club equipment or property intentionally or unintentionally by using the area or equipment outside of the intended parameters, the club reserves the right to impose a fee equal to the cost of repair or replacement.

Kids and Juniors Members

While in the club, children under the age of 14 must be involved in a structured club activity, or directly supervised by their parent, guardian or staff member. No Kids should be in an area or space of the facility that they cannot participate in. All members and guests under the age of 18 are subject to a facility curfew of 9pm.

Ages 10 and under

- Club use is limited to a maximum of two hours per day.
- May access Courthouse Kid's Court area during operational hours with a Kid's Membership or Kid's Court Drop in Fee of \$5.
- May use basketball courts, racquetball courts, pools and classes with direct adult supervision.
- May participate in any kids programming and/or classes without adult supervision.
- Classes should not be used as a childcare substitute and the child must be able to fully participate.
- All members age 17 and under will be subjected to curfew restrictions of 9pm.

Ages 11-13:

- Club use is limited to a maximum of two hours per day.
- May participate in a group exercise class with direct adult supervision.
- May use the indoor pool, outdoor pool and spa with direct adult supervision.
- May use cardio and weight equipment with direct adult supervision.
- May use the basketball and racquetball courts without adult supervision.
- All members age 17 and under will be subjected to curfew restrictions of 9pm.

Ages 14 and older:

- May use all club resources and amenities available to adult members.
- All members age 17 and under will be subjected to curfew restrictions of 9pm.

Indoor/outdoor pool policies

- The slide is open during supervised swim only.
- Running, diving, pushing, and other horseplay is prohibited in and around the pool area.
- A modest suit designed specifically for swimming is required.
- Swimwear cover-ups and shoes are required for re-entrance to the club.
- Members are allowed access to and from the pool through the club only.
- No person under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall use the pool.
- No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- No smoking on the pool deck or around Courthouse Club Fitness premises.
- No person suffering from a communicable disease or who has open wounds shall use the pool.
- Flotation devices such as air mattresses, tubes, or inflatable animals are not allowed in or around the pool.
- Children who are not fully potty trained must wear a swim diaper.
- All persons are required to take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
- All guests or members are subject to Courthouse' Guest Policies
- Children 13 years and younger must have direct adult supervision at all times on the pool deck.

Supervised Swim (Lifeguard on duty)

- Children 13 years and younger must have direct adult supervision at all times on the pool deck even when a Lifeguard is on duty.

Billing and payment

Payment methods

The most cost effective payment method is eBill. To set up eBill you will provide your banking account information. For all other methods of payment such as credit card, cash or check, a \$5 fee is assessed each month. Manual payments may be made in person at the service desk or mailed to P.O. Box 3125, Salem, Oregon, 97302.

Billing Policies

Each month, your recurring fees will post to your Courthouse account on the 1st and begin the billing process. On the 9th your club dues and fees will be drafted from the information on file (some banking institutions may take longer to process). Courthouse does not have the ability to change the draft day. The billing cycle is from the 1st-31st of each month. Payment is due in full by the 15th of the month. Any cash payments must be exact change.

Past due accounts

All accounts not paid in full by month-end and considered 30 days past due will receive a friendly reminder for payment . Accounts that become delinquent by 60 days will be assessed a late fee of non-payment and services will be terminated. Any termination Fees will then be applied. When an account reaches 90 days past due, it will be remitted to a collection agency.

On account charging privileges (House Charge)

For membership accounts paid by eBill, responsible parties on the account automatically receive charging privileges. By default children will have charging privileges. Should a parent or guardian wish to restrict charging privileges, they may do so by submitting a written request to Member Services via online platforms that can be found on Courthouse's Website, Chat function or by emailing member.services@courthousefit.com.

General Membership Policies

Consult your physician

Before you start on a new exercise program, we recommend you consult with your physician if you are over 40 and have been sedentary for a year or more; or if you have any of the following risk factors: cardiovascular disease, a family history of cardiovascular disease, diabetes, high blood pressure, elevated blood cholesterol, obesity, high level of stress, or if you are a smoker.

Club entry

Only members and their accompanying guests are allowed to enter the club. To gain admittance members must check-in at the service desk.

Restricted Access

Some membership options may have restricted access as it pertains to time or space within the facility. Should a member with a time or area restriction wish to use outside of their limitation, they may do so for a fee. For instance, our "Basic" membership provides club access from 12p-4p. Members with this membership type may use outside of this timeframe for an additional fee of \$10 per instance.

Changes to recurring services

All changes are to be submitted through online platforms that can be found on Courthouse's Website, Chat function or by emailing member.services@courthousefit.com. All changes are to be submitted in writing and/or completed with a signature. Ceasing to use club facilities will not be considered as notice of intent to terminate service, nor will ceasing to pay monthly fees. 30 days advance notice is required to change or cancel all recurring services.

Hold Policy

Members may "hold" their membership for a minimum of one calendar month and a maximum of three months due to an illness or injury that prevents them from using a majority of the club. The hold period extends any membership obligation by a like period. All hold requests are subject to management approval and may require a doctor's confirmation. Members may request one hold per calendar year. The fee to hold a membership is \$20 per month.

Unusual Closures

Hours of operation are subject to reasonable adjustment at the discretion of Courthouse management, including but not limited to changes for holidays, special occasions and for the performance of maintenance to facilities. Whenever possible, notice of such changes will be posted on Courthouse premises and/or website. Should all Courthouse facilities be unavailable for Member use for a period exceeding seven days due to damage by fire, act of God, catastrophe, accident, construction or extraordinary maintenance, the membership time shall be extended for a like period.

Extreme weather

During periods of extreme weather, sudden changes to the club schedule will be posted on our website and/or our social media channels.

Right to Deny Membership

Courthouse shall have the right to terminate a membership whenever management determines, in its sole discretion, that the continued existence of the membership is no longer in the best interest of Courthouse or other members. The following non-exclusive list of occurrences may constitute the basis for termination of a membership: when Member violates a Courthouse policy, procedure, or condition of membership; when Member abuses, destroys, or wrongfully damages Courthouse premises or property, which includes its business reputation; when Member abuses, verbally or physically harass, threatens, intimidates, or defames other members or Courthouse employees; when Member engages in theft of any property belonging to Courthouse or to a member or visitor; or when Member engages in the unauthorized use of, or conducts unauthorized activities on Courthouse premises.

Right to Price Increase

Courthouse shall reserve the right to increase or decrease dues as deemed necessary. A price increase does not void any contractual obligations on the part of the Member. Should dues be raised by more than 15%, a member will be released from any contractual obligation and be allowed to terminate membership without penalty.

Communication Policy

Courthouse communicates all official and promotional notices and updates via email and text message. Enrolling in a Courthouse membership and/or service provides Courthouse authorization to communicate via text message and email. Members may opt-out at any time.

Video/Audio Recording

For the purpose of member security, staff training and club promotion, audio and video recording equipment is present in various areas of Courthouse facilities. Members may be recorded visually and/or acoustically at any time. Courthouse may use photographic and/or video images in which a member appears in various media communications.

Oregon Law Governing Health Club Membership

IF YOU WISH TO CANCEL YOUR COURTHOUSE CLUB FITNESS MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT, WITHOUT PENALTY, YOU MAY CANCEL IT BY DELIVERING OR MAILING BY CERTIFIED MAIL A WRITTEN NOTICE TO COURTHOUSE CLUB FITNESS. THE NOTICE MUST SAY THAT YOU DO NOT WISH TO BE BOUND BY THE AGREEMENT AND MUST BE DELIVERED OR MAILED BEFORE MIDNIGHT OF THE THIRD BUSINESS DAY AFTER YOU SIGN THE AGREEMENT. THE NOTICE MUST BE MAILED TO: COURTHOUSE CLUB FITNESS, P.O. BOX 3125, SALEM, OREGON 97302. IF YOU CANCEL WITHIN THREE DAYS, COURTHOUSE CLUB FITNESS WILL RETURN TO YOU WITHIN 15 DAYS ALL AMOUNTS YOU HAVE PAID.

In addition, you may cancel your Membership Agreement for the following reasons: a) if you die or become physically unable to use a substantial portion of those health club services used by you from the date of this membership agreement until the time of disability. Your disability must be confirmed by an examination of a physician agreeable to you and Courthouse. b) If Courthouse goes out of business. c) If Courthouse moves its facility closest to your residence on the date of the Membership Agreement to a location more than five additional miles from that residence. d) If a facility, construction or improvement is not completed by the date represented in the membership agreement. e) If Courthouse materially changes the health club services promised as part of the initial Membership Agreement.

If you choose to cancel your Membership Agreement for reasons a) through e) stated above, you will receive a refund of any dues paid, up to an amount computed by dividing the total amount of dues paid in the month of cancellation by the number of weeks in the month for which the dues were paid and multiplying the result by the number of weeks remaining in the month. The reasonable administrative costs associated with the establishment of your membership, including any joining fee, will not be refunded. Any liquidated damage clause mentioned in this agreement will not apply to memberships that are terminated under the conditions mentioned above.
